

Each year Collins College offers more than \$100,000 in scholarships. The following list represents a summary of scholarship criteria, deadlines and awards for scholarships offered by the college. Details and applications may be obtained from the college Admissions Department.

**PLATINUM SCHOLARSHIP****Selection Criteria:**

Complete one of the following:

- Design an original CD cover for a recording artist or group of your choice.
- Create a computer networking bid proposal for a fictional recording company.
- Create a short film, comic book or game concept about a recording artist or group of your choice.
- For Interior Design new students, complete a research project on three prominent interior designers including your recommendations on each of them.
- For Interior Design continuing students, create a residential space plan for a recording studio lobby apartment including finish selections.

Not open to staff or immediate family members of Collins College staff or prior platinum scholarship winners.

**PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP****Selection Criteria:**

- 250 word essay explaining how scholarship would benefit financial need
- Reference from teacher, counselor, co-worker or professional demonstrating Academic Leadership

Not open to staff or immediate family members of Collins College staff or prior presidential scholarship winners.

**MERIT SCHOLARSHIP****Selection Criteria:**

Asset test in english, math and reading comprehension  
Interview

Not open to current students, staff or immediate family members of Collins College staff.

Only eligible once per academic year.

**Scholarship Awards:**

Top five scoring students in each testing session (Winter, Spring, Summer, Fall) will be awarded a \$1,000 tuition scholarship.

**Winter:** January 20, February 10, March 10, 2006  
**Spring:** April 7, May 5, June 23, 2006  
**Summer:** July 28, August 11, September 22, 2006  
**Fall:** October 20, November 10, December 8, 2006

**MARIE GLENNEN MEMORIAL TUITION SCHOLARSHIP**

Open to Collins College continuing students entering second or subsequent academic year of school. Previous winners not eligible.

Academic Achievement, Essay

**Scholarship Awards:**

Five (5) \$1000 Awards  
Maximum of \$5,000 total awards per year.

Applications accepted throughout the year.

Awards determined Jan., April, June, August & October.

**INSTITUTIONAL GRANT****Selection Criteria:**

- Financial need.
- Letter describing goals in chosen career field.
- Past academic achievement.

Must be awarded all federal and state financial aid they are eligible for (Pell, SEOG, State Grants and Stafford Loans).

Not open to staff or immediate family members of Collins College staff.

**Scholarship Awards:**

Awards up to \$1000 each

Early application priority.  
Applications accepted until all awards have been made per deadline date.

**F.U.S.E. FILM FESTIVAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Scholarships will be awarded to any currently enrolled Collins College students whose short, 4-10 minute film is selected as a first, second or third place winner in the college's annual F.U.S.E. Film Festival.
